

Basic MLA Bibliographic format for most print materials

1. Turn to the title page. 2. Write the information you find into the appropriate box. 3. Add any information regarding one chapter (if that's all you're going to use in the book) or the volume number/name. *You won't have something in every box, so don't panic.*
(Helpful Hint: write down the call number of the book so you can find again another day.) Your ending punctuation ↓

Your bib card (and works cited page) layout using the data above should look like this--

City of Publication: Publisher, copyright date. ## - ## (the
